

# **Scholarship Application Form**

This scholarship program is in recognition of the commitment our employees devote to their families and the success of TimpTe, and is intended to encourage continued growth and development through education.



**For the academic year 2018 – 2019, Timpte Inc. is excited to present the Timpte Scholarship Program. Scholarship awards must be applied toward the cost of tuition and fees in an undergraduate program.**

**Criteria:**

The applicant must be a dependent child no older than 24 years of age at the time of the application deadline. The applicant may reapply for consideration in a subsequent year of undergraduate study and is eligible for a maximum of four awards.

The applicant must be a dependent child of an active employee of Timpte, Inc. (David City, Branches, Thunderstone, and Colorado) at the time of the award.

The applicant must be accepted in a full-time two or four year program, and be registered for a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester. The funds will be paid directly to the college or university attended, per information provided by recipient containing verification of registration, college name, and mailing address.

The applicant must include the following items with their application:

**Applicants meeting the above criteria must submit the application along with the following items:**

- **Recommendation Letters.** Two sealed letters of recommendation – from non-family members; examples include, but not limited to, one from a high school or college teacher and one from a supervisor at an employer.
- **An official transcript.** The transcript should include GPA, SAT and/or ACT scores, and class rank. The purpose of the transcript is to verify GPA and candidate’s progress through educational program.

The completed scholarship application (including essay, transcript and letters of recommendation) must be received by a committee member by midnight on **March 2, 2018**. Timpte’s Scholarship Committee will review all submissions and schedule a personal interview with those applicants who have advanced to the final round of review and selection.

**The applicant will not be considered for this scholarship unless all required materials are submitted. Refer to the checklist on the last page of this application.**
