




## **Tarp Repair Kit Instructions**

Warning: it must be at least 65° to repair tarp effectively.

- 1. Make sure that your kit # 035-39446 includes the following parts:
  - a. Tarp remnant
  - b. HH-66 Vinyl Cement (Quart)
  - c. HH-66 Thinner (Pint)
- 2. Rough up and clean area to be patched with soap and water to remove dirt and debris.
- 3. Cut patch to fit over tear in tarp. Patch should be at least 2" larger than the tear. Round off the corners of the patch to prevent snagging corners.





- 4. Center the patch over the tear on the underside of the tarp.
- 5. Trace around the patch to mark where the glue will be applied.
- 6. To make sure that the patch adheres properly clean an area 1" larger that the patch using the HH-66 Thinner
- 7. Apply glue to the marked area on the tarp and on the patch. Allow cement to dry 2 5 minutes or until it becomes tacky.
- 8. Press the patch on the underside of the tarp and allow glue to dry for 1 to 24 hours. HH-66 Vinyl Cement's strength will increase the longer it is allowed to dry.
